BOB DAVENPORT (Geoffrey). Teacher at Joseph M. Hill School. Member National Collegiate Players. Attended U of A where he recently appeared in "Arms and The Man" and "Love in Spite of Papa." First FSLT appearance in "Janus" (1957); also on stage in "Skin of Our Teeth," "Curious Savage" and "Bus Stop." Directed "The Circle" and "The Heiress." Produced "Ladies in Retirement."

DENISE TIMMONS (Clemance). Housewife. Born and reared in France, coming to the United States in 1948. Settled in Fort Smith in 1951 when her husband was assigned to Fort Chaffee. Her first FSLT appearance.
