75 years ago, Hollywood director, Victor Fleming, ran afoul of David O. Selznick and the powers that be during the filming of *Gone with the Wind*, and was replaced by director, George Cukor. While this is an interesting tidbit of trivia for movie buffs, it actually proved to be of great historical and cinematic significance as Cukor went from that project to another over at MGM studios – a movie based on L. Frank Baum's *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz*, starring a then-unknown Judy Garland. Since then, generations of audiences have been enchanted by the music and the story, and the bar for cinematic entertainment was permanently raised.
